(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

- A) First Party is a multi-disciplinary, research-focused University/ college/ institution offering a full range of academic programs at the undergraduate and postgraduate level providing a strong foundation in the disciplines of Pharmaceutical, Biotechnology and Healthcare Sciences named:
 - B. Pharmacy (4-year)
 - M. Pharmacy in Pharmaceutics, Pharmacology, Pharmacy practice and Regulatory affairs(2-year)
 - Pharm D (6-year)
 - Pharm D Post Baccalaureate (3-year)
- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The Parties intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within areas of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MoU for advancing their mutual interests.
- E) HRPIPER, THE SECOND PARTY, is multi-disciplinary, research-focused University/ college/ institution offering a full range of academic programs at the undergraduate and doctorate level providing a strong foundation in the disciplines of Pharmaceutical Science under one roof named.
 - B. Pharmacy (4-year)
 - M. Pharmacy in Pharmaceutics, Quality Assurance, Pharmaceutical Chemistry(2-year)
 - PhD Program (Pharmacy).
- F) HRPIPER, the Second Party is an independent a multi-disciplinary, research-focused Institution.
- G) The associated university is established in 2004, with office in Shirpur, Maharashtra offering education and research related activities to students. The University/Institution is approved by Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi and University Grant Commission

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1

CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of the First Party and Second Party Faculty in providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable research, teaching and training systems.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MoU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MoU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2

SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological upgradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close cooperation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training Methodology, and suitably customize the curriculum.
- 2.3 Student/Faculty Exchange Programs: Both Parties will mutually accepts to exchange students and faculties for sharing of information and Research related activities on regular basis as mutually accepted
- 2.4 Research and Development: Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of Pharmaceutical Sciences
- 2.5 Skill Development Programs: Both Parties to train the students of on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

- 2.6 Guest Lectures: Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest/lecturers to the students of the First Party and vice a versa on the new trends in technology and respective new in-house requirements for the industry at large.
- 2.7 Faculty Development Programs: Second Party to train the Faculty of First Party and vice a versa for imparting training as per the industrial requirements considering the National Occupational Standards in the concerned sector, if available.
- 2.8 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmed on the terms specified herein.
- 2.9 There is no financial commitment on both the parties, the First Party to take up any programmed mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial-consideration, it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE 3

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copyrights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4

VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on agreed terms, during which period HRPIPER, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MoU. Any act on the part of Training Partner or HRPIPER, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc. shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU.
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MoU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE 5

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that CCP Landran and HRPIPER are acting under this MoU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make

any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Headquarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Mohali.

It is hereby specifically mentioned that this MoU is signed between both the parties; exclusively for the Student and Faculty Exchange of Chandigarh college of Pharmacy, Landran, Mohali 140307.
