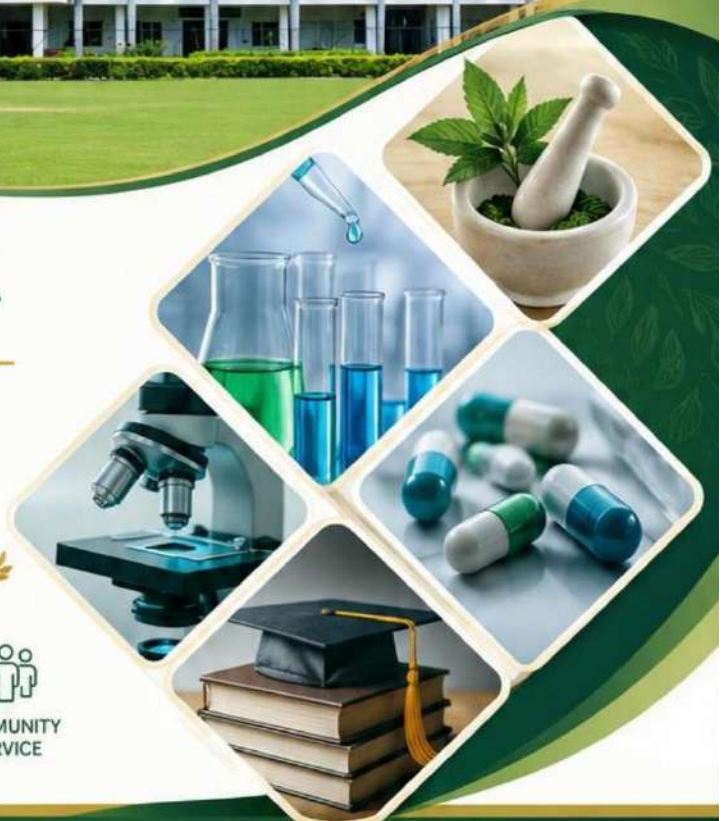

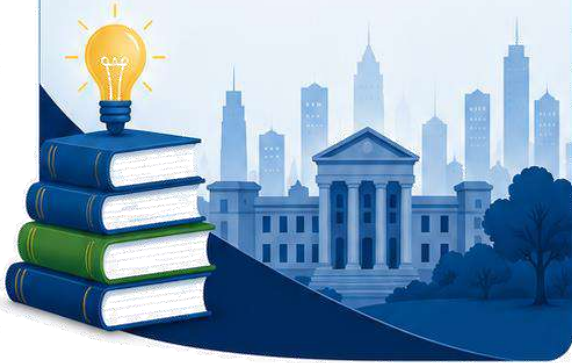

Meditation and Technology: Finding Balance in a Digitally-Driven World
