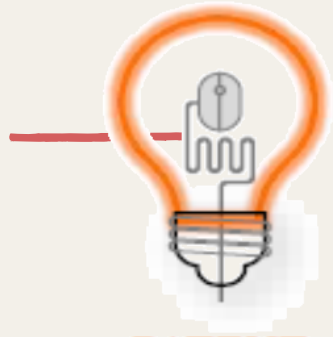

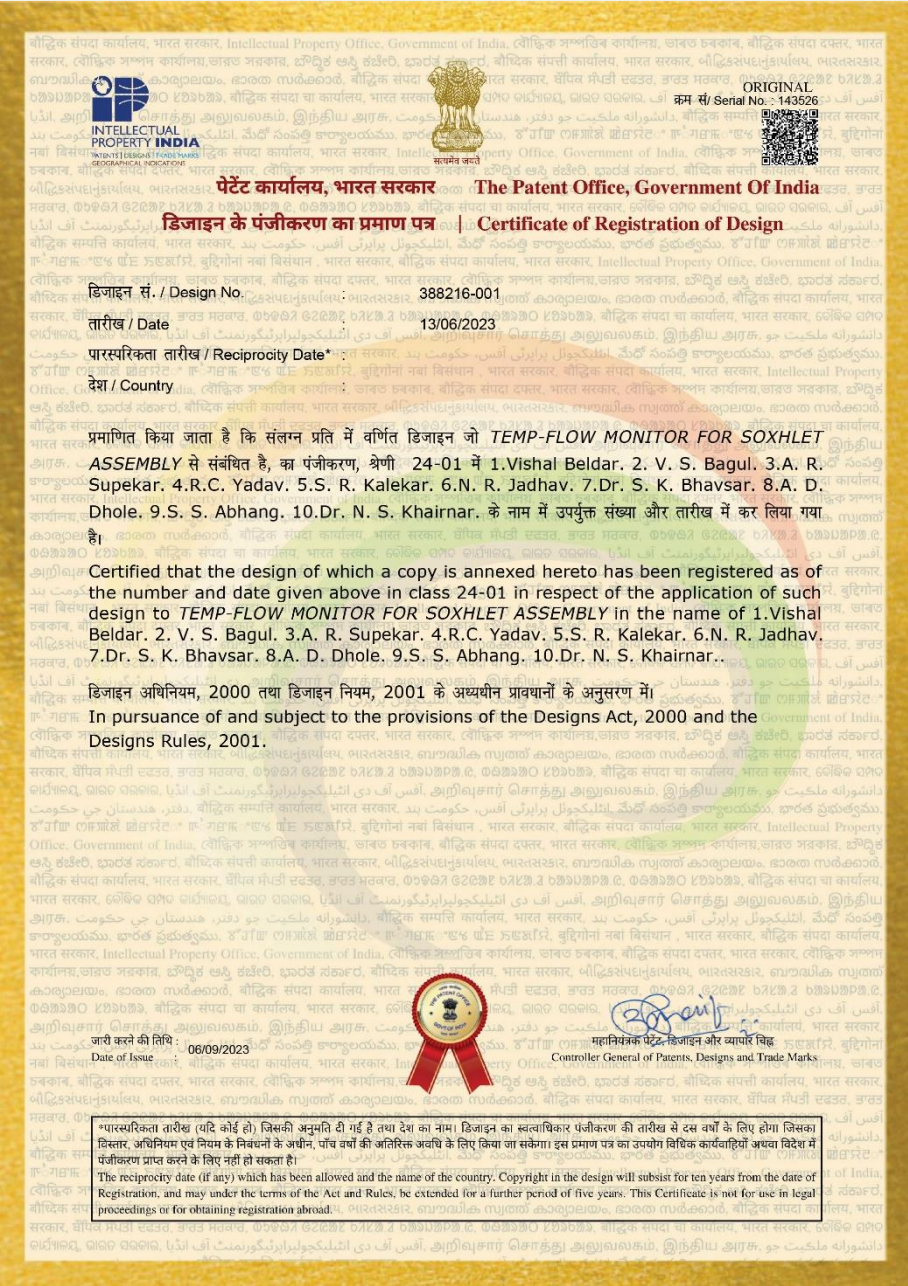

2. TRADEMARK

- It is a distinctive sign that **Identifies certain goods or services** as those produced or provided by a **specific person or enterprise**.
- It may be one or combination of words, **letters or numerals**.
- It is a proof of **Ownership** and hence provides **Rights to the Proprietor**.

- Provides **Protection** to the **owner** of the mark by ensuring the **exclusive rights to identify**.

- It also helps consumers to **Identify goods**.
- The term of registration is for a term of **10 years**.





3. COPYRIGHT

- legal term describing **Rights** given to **Creators** for their **Works**.
- These works include:
- Literary works such as **Novels, Poems, plays, Reference Works, Newspapers , Computer Programs Databases, Films, Musical & Choreography.**
- Artistic works such as **Drawings, Paintings, Photographs & Architecture.**
- **Advertisements.**
- **Maps & Technical Drawings.**

4. *GEOGRAPHICAL INDICATION*

- These are signs used on goods that have a specific geographical origin.
- Agricultural products are its main concern as they typically have qualities which are derived from their place of production & are influenced by local factors such as climate & soil.
- **Darjeeling tea** is the **1st Geographical Indication** tagged product in India.

5. INDUSTRIAL DESIGN

- Industrial design refers to creative activity
- Design rights refers to novel or optimal design that is accorded to the proprietor of a validly registered design
